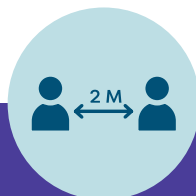


ENTRY REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS

Incheba, Inc. allows entry to the Incheba Expo Bratislava premises only to those individuals who are either vaccinated, have a negative test result for COVID-19 or those who did overcome COVID-19 (hereinafter referred to as the "OTP-person mode") in accordance with the Decree issued by the Public Health Authority of the Slovak Republic.

- All visitors are obliged to cover their face with mask, respirator without an exhalation valve, scarf or a shawl in all indoor and outdoor places during the whole time.**
- Entry to the premises is only allowed to individuals in the OTP-person mode who meet one of the following conditions:**
 - a/ a person at least 14 days after the administration of the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine with a two-dose schedule, or
 - b/ a person at least 21 days after the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine with a single-dose schedule, or
 - c/ a person at least 14 days after the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine if the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine was administered within 180 days after the person overcame COVID-19, or
 - d/ a person who is able to show a negative COVID-19 test result not older than 72 hours in case of RT-PCR or LAMP, or
 - e/ a person who is able to show a negative COVID-19 test result not older than 48 hours in case of an antigen test, or
 - f/ a person who did overcome the COVID-19 infection not more than 180 days ago, or
 - g/ people under 12 years of age.
- The visitor is obliged to identify themselves with a COVID-19 vaccine certificate, or with a negative test result for COVID-19, or with a confirmation of the COVID-19 disease overcome; such certificates can be replaced with the EU Digital COVID Certificate if such was issued; otherwise the guest is obliged to show a relevant document from which the identity of the person can be determined.**
- The visitors are obliged to keep the 2m distance between each other, with the exception of members of the same household.**
- Shaking hands is prohibited.**
- We kindly ask visitors to use the disinfection located at each entry to a hall.**
